A free information session about haemochromatosis will be held at Club On East in Sutherland on Saturday 26 August 2017 from 2.00 – 4.00 pm.

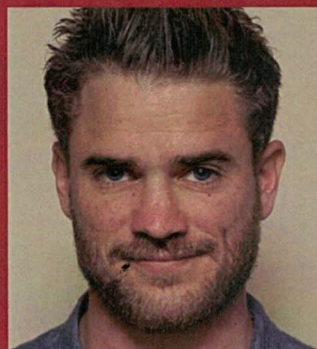
